



# 1. RESTORATION SUMMARY

*December & January  
2012/2013*

## Restoration Activities:

- During the month of December, volunteers from the Makaha Hawaiian Civic Club visited Kaho'olawe . Volunteers participated in restoring the hard pan areas near Kaneloa Gulch using mulch from project areas in Kealialalo.
- The first Audubon Christmas bird count was held during the week of December 18<sup>th</sup>.
- In January Volunteers from Lahainaluna, Four Seasons Resort Wailea, Montessori, & Kahuku High School visited Kaho'olawe. Volunteers from these groups contributed time towards the HCF/NOAA coastal restoration grant in Honokanai`a.

## Other News:

- Six additional sediment tube traps were deployed off Hakioawa Iki and Lae `O Kuikui in support of the upcoming DOH III grant.
- The Hakioawa Weather Station recorded a total of 1.61 inches of precipitation in January, while Honokanai`a Weather Station recorded 0.95 inches of precipitation. December totals were significantly less, with both stations recording less than 0.20 inches of precipitation.
