



# 1. RESTORATION SUMMARY

*October & November  
2012*

## Restoration Activities:

- During the month of October, volunteers from the Kona Young Farmers, Anuenue Charter School, and the Four Seasons Resort Maui visited Kaho'olawe.
- In the month of November, volunteers from Kua O Ka La charter school, Mid Pacific Institute, and a second round of volunteers from the Four Seasons Resort Maui, and Kona Young Farmers spent four days on Kaho'olawe.
- Volunteers all contributed working hours to the NRCS wetland restoration project by cutting and chipping kiawe, weed whacking non-native grasses, and planting native shrubs and grasses.

## Other News:

- Three sediment tube traps were deployed in about thirty feet of water at Hakioawa.
- Officials from NRCS did a sight visit on November 29 and 30 to check on progress of the grant.
- The restoration program welcomes La'akea Alapa'i-Wallace. He will be interning with the program through Americorps / Kupu, for a ten month period.
- The DOH III grant (Reducing Excessive Sedimentation in the Hakiaowa Watershed of Kaho'olawe Island) was awarded on October 19<sup>th</sup>.
