Restoration activities

Volunteer Activities:

- During the month of September 22 volunteers from the Americorps program worked in Kealialalo watering plants and weeding.

Faunal Restoration:

- Pueo and mice were surveyed in September and reveal a sharp decline in numbers for both species.
- 28 Feral cats were trapped covering the coastal areas from Honokanai`a to Kaukukupapa over a three night period.

Ka Palupalu O Kanaloa:


