#### **“Earth & Sea” Spotlights Kaho‘olawe**

KHNL News 8 will spotlight environmental conservation and preservation work underway within the Kaho`olawe Island Reserve on three consecutive Wednesdays, beginning Wednesday, August 6, as part of its ***Earth and Sea Project: Going Green in Hawai'i***. Scheduled dates and times are:
