Members of the Kaho'olawe Island Reserve Commission (KIRC) will convene their regular monthly meeting at 9 a.m., Tuesday, April 29 in Conference Rooms #1 and #2 of the J. Water Cameron Center, 95 Mahalani Street in Wailuku. The public is cordially invited to attend.

Among the Commission's agenda action items are several presentations, including: the KIRC Strategic Plan for FY 09 to FY 13; a presentation for approval of a proposed staff reorganization; the KIRC's proposed budget for FY 09; and an update on a draft Burial Site Assessment. *
