Commission to meet on Kaho'olawe

The Kaho'olawe Island Reserve Commission (KIRC) will convene a limited meeting on the Island of Kaho'olawe this Friday and Saturday, August 1 and 2, for the purposes of assessing current and future projects and on-island operations.

During the commissioners' two-day on-island site visit, members will evaluate existing and possible future projects for the KIRC's Cultural, Ocean Resources, and Restoration (flora and faunal) programs as well current and future operations and improvements at Honokanai'a.
