SUBJECT:	Authorize the Executive Director to Extend Communications Contract for FY25

<u>RECOMMENDED MOTION</u>:

To authorize the Executive Director to extend the Communications Contract with Harmer Radio and Electronics, Inc. for the period May 01, 2024, through April 30, 2025, in the amount of \$74,876.77.

BACKGROUND & SUMMARY:

The Communications Contract was extended once in FY22 to Harmer Radio and Electronics, Inc for \$75,012. This will be the second of three extensions for the current contract. Harmer has an increased labor cost of 3% but it is offset by the savings from switching from analog to digital handheld radios.

LEGAL AUTHORITY:

The relevant provisions of Chapter 6K, Hawai'i Revised Statutes, read as follows:

[§6K-6] Responsibilities and duties of the commission. The general administration of the island reserve shall rest with the commission. In carrying out its duties and responsibilities, the commission...

(2) Shall approve all contracts for services and rules pertaining to the island reserve...

[§6K-9.5] Kaho`olawe rehabilitation trust fund. (b) The commission may use moneys in the trust fund to carry out the purposes of this chapter, including hiring employees, specialist and consultants necessary to complete projects relating to the purposes of this chapter.
